What is FOCUS?

• FOCUS is an **all-expense-paid** research education and mentoring initiative sponsored by the National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute (NHLBI). The **one-year program** begins with a **Summer Institute (July 13-18, 2025)** at UC San Diego in La Jolla, CA, which includes **in-depth training in grant writing**.

Who is FOCUS for?

 The program aims to improve the long-term success of early career faculty in the areas of heart, lung, blood, and sleep. Junior faculty and postdocs transitioning to a faculty position with a research focus centered on heart, lung, blood, or sleep disorders; health disparities relevant to heart, lung, blood, or sleep disorders; or relevant research methodologies and approaches specific to these areas are encouraged to apply. How can I apply?

• The application process requires initial submission of a pre-application at **pridecc.wustl.edu/ apply**. While applications remain open until all positions are filled, we recommend that FOCUS candidates submit their pre-application by **March 16, 2025**.
