PAID SUMMER RESEARCH EXPERIENCE

Through a partnership with the American Heart Association, mentored 10- to 12-week summer research experiences are available for at least three students from ethnic and racial groups under-represented in science.

Current AHA awardees will serve as mentors for this program.

STUDENT ELEGIBILITY

- Candidate may be pursuing a degree in any field but must have expressed an interest in a healthcare related field.
- Full-time undergraduate, rising sophomore, junior or senior.
- Exemplary academic performance.
- Students from under-represented ethnic or racial groups in the sciences.

PROGRAM BENEFITS

- \$6,000 stipend
- Room & board on campus, if student is not locally-based
- Opportunity to travel to an AHA scientific meeting
