What is FOCUS?

 FOCUS is an all-expense-paid research education and mentoring initiative sponsored by the National Heart, Lung and Blood Institute (NHLBI). The one-year commitment begins with a Summer Institute (July 7-20, 2021). Note that while travel to the UC San Diego School of Medicine and NHLBI campuses is included in the program, some of the in-person meetings may be changed to a virtual format to avoid travel and protect everyone's health during the COVID-19 pandemic. Participants will be informed of the program content and format accordingly.

Who is FOCUS for?

 The program is dedicated to improving the long-term success of early career faculty from groups underrepresented (URM) in the biomedical workforce. Research-oriented junior faculty and transitioning postdocs who are women, persons with disability, or <u>designated as URM</u> by UC San Diego Health Sciences are encouraged to apply. How can I apply?

• The application process starts with submitting the pre-application at **pridecc.wustl.edu/apply**. While applications remain open until all positions are filled, we recommend that candidates to FOCUS submit the pre-application by **March 1, 2021.**
