

GLOBAL HOPE SICKLE CELL DISEASE DIRECTED COURSE

ABOUT THE COURSE

Global HOPE's sickle cell disease (SCD) training program for primary care providers in resource-limited settings seeks to improve the clinical care of children diagnosed with SCD. The course will teach local clinicians who provide the initial care to children how to manage SCD. Upon completing this course, the participant will know how to:

- Diagnose SCD including awareness of the clinical and laboratory features of the various forms of SCD.
- Guide SCD-affected families on how to maintain health and reduce the risk of complications due to SCD.
- Manage complications of SCD such as pain, fever, acute chest syndrome, stroke, etc.
- Safely transfer those with severe complications to a higher level of care.
